# MAKING A DIFFERENCE TOGETHER



HFCL is supporting the educational needs of DIVYANG children at Balwantray Mehta Vidya Bhawan, Greater Kailash -II, New Delhi. It has also provided a grant for transportation, Smart Class System and renovation of Printing Press at the School.



Our Gurugram and GK-II employees visited SHEOWS ('Guru Vishram Vridh Ashram' at Garhmukteshwar, Uttar Pradesh), and interacted with the elderly people residing there, who have been diagnosed with Alzheimer's, Dementia, and other such disorders.

HFCL employees also served lunch to the senior citizens and in some cases, even helped to feed them. There was a lot to share and also learn from the experience of seniors residing there.

Overall, it was a very fulfilling and gratifying day for the employees who volunteered for this noble cause.

#### To gift a life with dignity to the elderly residents of Guru Vishram Vridh Ashram, HFCL has:

- Constructed a new accommodation facility, in order to provide shelter to over 100
  needy Senior Citizens
- Developed a 24-bed Hospital, including two ICU facilities
- Provided advanced medical equipment and Physiotherapy facilities
- Installed Solar Power System to provide uninterrupted power supply
- Dispensed low floor beds for resident Senior Citizens
- Furnished all required hospital furniture and other essential items



HFCL supports the educational needs of DIVYANG children at Balvantray Mehta Vidya Bhawan, Greater Kailash-II, New Delhi. Under 'SAMARTH' program. We provide complete educational expenses of 46 children.

We have also provided a grant for transportation facilities, a Smart Class System, and renovation of the school Printing Press.

- Meet & Greet with our adopted students and their parents
- Provided Breakfast packets to the students

- HFCL Goa plant organized a specialize health camp where beneficiaries received expert medical advice
- HFCL Goa Plant also held a Blood Donation Camp in association with Goa Medical College
- HFCL employees volunteered for this camp and donated their blood for this novel cause

Social Responsibility goes hand-in-hand with environmental consciousness. The excitement and energy was palpable as the volunteers did an outstanding job with their teamwork and camaraderie.

- Carrying forward HFCL's vision of building an eco-friendly future, 51 trees were planted across the HFCL Hyderabad premises during this occasion
- HFCL Hyderabad employees turned up in good numbers for both the drives and set an example by leading from the front



HTL Chennai Plant organized a plethora of social activities, amidst active participation from the employees.

- HTL Employees visited the Chennai Primary School, Ekkattuthangal, and interacted with the students
- Lunch packets, notebooks, and racks were arranged for 250 school children
- School Fire Extinguishers & Stands (with buckets) were also handed over
- Organized a Blood Donation Camp in association with the Rotary Club of Chennai (Ullagaram)
- 54 HTL employees voluntarily participated in the noble cause, donating blood and igniting hope
- In a bid to reduce overall carbon footprint, employees planted 40 saplings around the campus. Further to this a sapling distribution drive was also organized, wherein 350+ saplings were handed over to the people residing around our Plant's premises for plantation
- HTL Chennai, in association with Dr. Mohan's Diabetes Specialities Centre Pvt. Ltd. and Tabata, organized a specialized health camp where 100 beneficiaries received expert advice on diabetes management, diet planning, and fitness



During CSR WEEK 2023, HTL Hosur employees participated in a Tree Plantation Drive and Blood Donation Camp.

- HTL employees planted around 50 saplings, and distributed 250 saplings among other people for plantation
- A Blood Donation Camp was organized at our HTL Hosur Plant in association with the Lions Club of Hosur, where 46 employees came forward to voluntarily donate their blood and supported this noble cause whole-heartedly.



## MOBILE MEDICAL UNITS: FILLING THE GAP IN PREVENTIVE HEALTHCARE

With a focused approach in doorstep Preventive Healthcare, HFCL set up Mobile Medicare Units to cater to the needy and marginalized sections of society residing in remote areas.

At present, a battery of 8 Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) are operational, providing 350,000 households convenient access to better health. We have been successful in touching the lives of 800+ beneficiaries every day with preventive healthcare facilities. Till date, we have administered over a million treatments, and counting!


Each MMU is accompanied by a professional healthcare team comprising of an MBBS doctor, a lab technician, and a pharmacist. It is equipped to offer diagnostics, medicines, Pathological tests, ECG, etc., all of which are made available to the beneficiaries free of cost.

The implementing agencies manage its day-to-day operations and mobilize greater participation of the targeted communities with the help of a MSW Qualified SPO (Social Protection Officer).



Throughout HFCL CSR Week 2023, the 8 Mobile Medical Units stationed at different locations – Solan (Himachal Pradesh), Goa, Sardarshahar (Rajasthan; 2 Units), Ghazipur (Uttar Pradesh), Hyderabad (Telangana), Chennai, and Hosur - collectively reached out to more than 8,000 beneficiaries by organizing different activities:

- Specialized Health Camp ENT Specialists, Gynecologists, Ophthalmologists, Dermatologists, Orthopedists, etc. were available for consultation
- Pathological tests were carried out at the Mobile Medical Units
- · Medicines were prescribed and given free of cost
- Awareness drives and camps all through the week such as Cancer Awareness Camp, Diabetes Care, Dental Care, Geriatric Care, Health & Hygiene, Gender-based Health Issues, Communicable Diseases & its Prevention, etc.
